

Articles of Association

(Dated April 23, 2016)

ARTICLE 1 Name of Organization:

The name of the organization is Los Paseos Neighborhood Association (LPNA).

ARTICLE 2 Boundaries:

The area covered by LPNA is bounded by Bernal Road from Santa Teresa Boulevard to the Monterey Highway, and Cheltenham Way and the Coyote Alamitos Canal, from Santa Teresa Boulevard to the Monterey Highway.

ARTICLE 3 Purpose:

The purpose of LPNA shall be to promote the social welfare of the community by encouraging community involvement and providing a means for the neighborhood to address its needs, including: schools, safety, traffic, zoning, and recreation.

ARTICLE 4 Nonprofit:

LPNA is a nonprofit public benefit organization and is not organized for the private gain of any person.

ARTICLE 5 Dedication:

The property of LPNA is irrevocably dedicated to social welfare purposes and no part of the net income or assets of LPNA shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or other private person.

ARTICLE 6 Dissolution:

Upon the dissolution or winding up of LPNA, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of LPNA shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for social welfare purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue code Section 501(c)(4). Remaining unused grant funds shall be returned to the funding agency.
